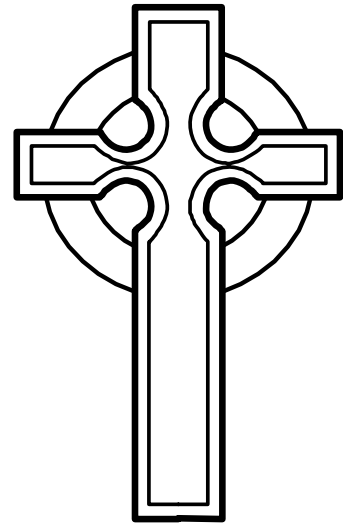

## Who We Are

We are a warm, friendly church that seeks to worship and serve the triune God in an atmosphere of love and fervent Christian fellowship. We have endeavored to make all of the worship to teach us about our Sovereign God and our loving Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. We build our services to be both enriching and satisfying.

We are a doctrinal and confessional church. Although we live in a day of doctrinal fuzziness, we believe a person cannot have a stable and balanced Christian life without a solid foundation. Therefore, by using the historic London Baptist Confession of Faith, we strive to be clear and precise in what we believe. This way, every member will understand, and be able to provide scriptural proofs as the reason for their faith.

It is our desire for every Christian in the visible church to be actively engaged in “the King’s service.” Consider the parts of our name which express what we seek to accomplish at Providence Reformed Bible Church:

### **Providence . . .**

reminds us that we have a wonderful God, who put all things in their place before the world began and who is guiding all things. We center on Him because He teaches us how to worship Him, speak of Him, and how to live for Him through His Word. As we are reminded of these things, we seek to direct our worship services to please Him and not ourselves. We serve the God of Providence who lovingly involves himself in all aspects of history and our individual lives.

### **Reformed . . .**

guides us to the Reformation and Great Awakening that God brought forth. The five distinguishing marks of the Reformation are:

- Scripture alone is our standard
- by Christ alone we are saved
- by Faith alone we are justified
- through Grace alone is salvation
- all things exist for the glory of God alone

## **Bible . . .**

Is the very standard of our faith. It is the only sufficient, certain, and infallible rule of all saving Knowledge, Faith and Obedience. Therefore, we seek to develop all things as the Bible guides us through:

- preaching, singing, and prayer centering on God and His Holiness
- evangelism being true to the Gospel and trusting in God to bring the increase
- the church being elder led, as shown in the Scripture

## **Church . . .**

reflects the glory of God among the people of God and is His chosen instrument for reaching others for Christ by:

- centering on the Lordship of Christ
- promoting a believing, and active membership in His Church
- emphasizing that all are to live a life centered upon God and His Righteousness

## **God's Way of Salvation**

God is absolutely and perfectly holy and will only allow perfection into His Heaven.

Every one of us is a sinner before God and has broken His Holy Law. We naturally rebel against His ways and find ourselves guilty before God.

You cannot do anything to save yourself and make yourself right with God. You cannot do enough good works to gain God's favor and salvation.

## **What Shall I Pray?**

If you truly desire to be saved from your personal sin, then pray the following...

Admit that you are sinful and confess your sins to God.

Confess that you deserve to be punished for your sins.

Say to God that you have no power to change yourself and ask the Lord Jesus to help you repent and believe.

Ask the Lord Jesus to save you and make you fit for His Kingdom.

Trust Him to be the Savior and Lord of your life.

Believe God will hear and answer your prayer, according to the promises of His Word.
